Practitioners have included philosophers, priests, teachers, politicians, scribes, Liberians, etc. Knowledge Management efforts typically focus on organizational objectives such as improved performance, competitive advantage, innovation, the sharing of lessons learned, integration and continuous improvement of the organization.</li> <li>2. Knowledge can never be destroyed it can only be converted from one form to another.</li> <li>3. Knowledge is obtained by successful application of tools which extract it from raw data and processed information.</li> <li>4. Knowledge Management has been implemented since late 1990s, first in the business sector, and then in higher education and now in library management.</li> <li>5.
