



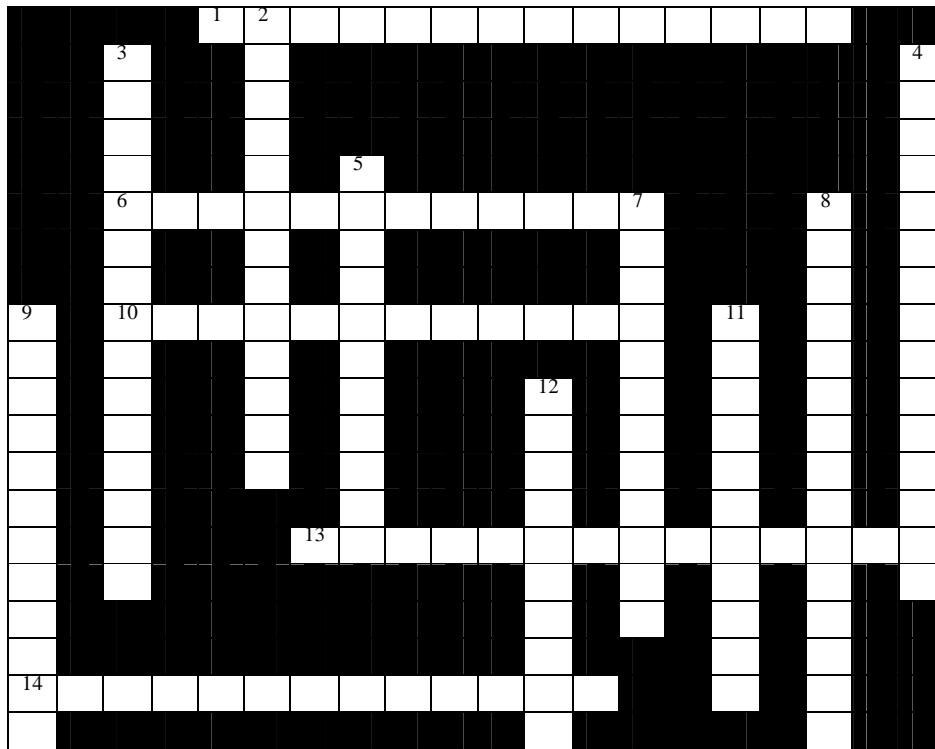
CROSSWORD PUZZLE COMPETITION
