| Aim of the Event | No matter how good out technical knowledge is, it is imperative for an individual to have good communication skills. It is through speaking our mind and the power of expressions that one can make his presence felt and carve a niche for himself in the work area. Hence a session was organized on the above mentioned area keeping in mind the same. |
| Event Description: | <p>In recent years it has become increasingly common for employers to request job applicants who are successfully short listed to deliver one or more presentations at their interview. The purpose of this presentation is to test the candidate's skills and abilities in communication coupled with an evaluation of knowledge of the area of presentation. This is one of the many ways in which RDIAS prepares its students for future growth.</p> <p>In presentations, students were judged on following parameters:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Communication Skills• Organization of Presentation• Topic Knowledge• Creativity• Summarization• Physical Appearance and Stage Presence |

Nine groups of students were asked to present on the profiles of different companies, like Ciena India, Daffodil, Safe net, TCS, Birlasoft and more. After the presentation, feedback was given to students by their fellow mates and faculty members for making the activity fruitful.

Then there is group discussion which forms the primary stage of contact between the interviewer and interviewee. These are entrance procedures adopted at the recruitment stage by many companies. Group discussions once more separates the cream group and makes them eligible for further rounds of tests so as to be chosen in an accurate career position. At RDIAS, the stress is mainly on these types of activities so that our students perform well in critical situations and make us proud!

Topics for Group Discussion were: “Should Sonia Gandhi be made PM of India” and “Joint Family is blessing in disguise”. Each group session lasted for ten minutes, in which students were evaluated on following parameters:

- ✓ Initiative/ Conclusion
- ✓ Content
- ✓ Body Language
- ✓ Voice Level/Clarity
- ✓ Team Playing Ability

With the aim of enhancing group discussion and presentation skills in our students, this activity was successfully conducted. Effective feedback at the end of the session made the activity more effective.
