The discussion followed feedback from the audience as well as the faculty co-ordinator. A composite score for each student out of a total of 50 marks was calculated based on the criteria of Initiative/Conclusion, Content, Body Language, Voice Level/Clarity, and Team Playing Ability.

The idea behind the activity was to make the students understand the fact that:-
