



**“Mock Interview Session -MBA III Semester (Finance Specialization)”**

<b>Topic :</b>	Mock Interview Session for students of MBA III Semester, specializing in Finance
<b>Date of event :</b>	August 17, 2011
<b>Aim of the Event</b>	Specialization interviews aim at assessing the student’s knowledge and understanding of concepts.
