Aim of the Event	<p>“The roots of competitive education are bitter, but the fruit is sweet.”</p> <p>The significance of positive competitive attitude and competitive education is a well known fact. Keeping these factors in mind RDIAS organized an online quiz contest called RDIAS GEMS for the students of MBA and MCA. The students participated in teams of two. There were a total of 20 teams from both the disciplines. It was an attempt from RDIAS to check the domain knowledge, technical abilities, team work and skills of the RDIAS Students.</p>
Description of the event:	<p>The students participated enthusiastically in the activity which aimed at testing their knowledge in their respective domains, team work, logical ability, time management skills and concentration power.</p> <p>This online quiz was completely objective in nature and had three rounds:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The 1st Round was – Qualifying Aptitude round, common for all the students. It had 50 questions to be answered in 60 minutes.2. The 2nd Round was – Basic Technical round, separate for MBA and

MCA participants. It had **45** questions from their respective domains, to be answered in 45 minutes.

3. **The 3rd and final round** was related to in-depth domain knowledge.

It had 30 advanced level questions to be answered in 30 minutes to test students' analytical ability as well as level of knowledge.

The winning teams were encouraged with "**Cash Prizes & Certificate of Merit**". Three winning teams were selected each from MBA & MCA. The event in its essence was an effort on part of RDIAS to make the students understand the fact that:
