Description of the event	<p>Students from MBA & MCA student visited the Asola Bhatti Wildlife Sanctuary under the supervision of two faculty members.</p> <p>The RDIAS group was welcomed by Dr.Ahmed and taken to the Conservation Education Centre. The Asola wildlife sanctuary is located in South Delhi Distt, all along Delhi Haryana Faridabad & Gurgaon. The approach is from Tughlakabad (Mehruali Badarpur Road) to Surajkund Road (2 Km) near Karni Singh shooting Range or from Mehruali via Chattarpur Temple 6 Km near Sanjay Colony(Bhatti Area).</p> <p>The main components of the visit were: Introduction by Dr. Ahmed about the Sanctuary, Nature Trail and Documentary on Vanishing Vultures.</p>

After the introduction, the group proceeded for the Nature Trail. Birds such as Black Buck, Blue Bulls and plants mesmerized the students. During the trail, it was realised that nature plays a beautiful role in our co-existence.

The visit ended with a documentary on The Vanishing Vultures. India had a population of 8.5 crores of vultures ten years back and now only 4000 vultures are remaining. The documentary made the students aware about the causes of Vanishing Vulture and how can this be fought back.
