



RDIAS Social Club Collaborates with Pratham: Step towards CSR

Topic :	A collaborative effort by RDIAS students with 'Pratham' (an NGO providing quality education to the underprivileged children of India)
Date of event :	January 25 and 27, 2012
Aim of the Event :	It is the fundamental right of every individual to receive basic education without which he can not fully discharge his duties as an aware and responsible citizen. Students of RDIAS visited MCD primary school in Mangolpuri area under the umbrella of Pratham for the above mentioned objective.
Event Report in brief :	<p>Student volunteers of RDIAS visited MCD Primary School, Mangolpuri on January 25, 2012. Chief Coordinator at Pratham, Ms. Pallavi Kakaji, divided the students in four groups. One group was headed by Miss Nisha and other by Miss Tripta, executives of Pratham. Our students were witness to several activities like story telling, picture reading, drawing, fun games etc. which were carried by Pratham trainer in the School Based Library (SBL) Program.</p> <p>On January 27 2012, our students visited Pratham head office at Patel Nagar. They met up with Ms. Pallavi Kakaji who discussed and planned the forthcoming activity. She provided three different sheets of interview questions, one each for Head Master of school, volunteers of Pratham and children. Each sheet comprised 20 questions which were related to different parameters like performance of volunteer, effectiveness of program etc.</p> <p>The first sheet had questions for Head Master of school regarding the library programme provided by Pratham, its usefulness and feasibility, suggested improvements and further modifications if required. The</p>

second sheet asked questions related to performance of volunteers in SBL programme. The third sheet comprised questions regarding children activities, importance of these and interest and participation of students in such activities.

She told the volunteers that each group will present a report on the basis of this small interview. Students of RDIAS also discussed various questions regarding activities of Pratham and its contribution towards the betterment of students.
